



A1: They're at the +Q1: "Where are the children?" beach. + Q2: "Who is the boy?" A2: He's Nam. + Q3" Is that girl Mai?" \rightarrow Introduce a new friend, A3: No, she isn't. Akiko. -Listen - Set the context: "Today, Nam goes to the beach. Nam meets a new friend. Her name is Akiko. Listen to what they are talking about." - Play recording, have pupils listen to the dialogue. - Listen - Play recording again, let pupils listen and repeat - Listen and repeat sentence by sentence - Have pupils think of Nam's question and Akiko's -Answer: *Where are you* answer in the picture: from, Akiko? - I'm from Japan. - Show the structure and teach how to ask and answer - Listen and repeat. about where someone is from: "Where are you from? \rightarrow I'm from Japan."
